



DECREE
of the
Diocese of Kansas City ~ St. Joseph

In accord with the prescriptions of the *Code of Canon Law*, Canons 120§1; 121; 374§1; and 515§s 2 & 3, and having consulted the Presbyteral Council, I hereby revise and promulgate the boundaries of **Saint Patrick (quasi)-Parish, in Ford City, Missouri as follows:**

Begin at t385th Street at the Gentry / Nodaway County line; south along the Gentry / Nodaway and Andrew County lines to the Gentry / DeKalb County line; east along the Gentry / DeKalb County line to the Gentry / Daviess County line; north along the Gentry / Daviess and Harrison County lines to 385th Street; west along 385th Street to the beginning.

The reason for this decree is the ccreation of separte canonical boundaries for Saint Patrick (quasi)-Parish in Ford City, thereby bringing it to more closely conform to the norm of Canon Law.

The effective date of the canonical establishment of Saint Patrick (quasi)-Parish is April 7, 2010. Promulgation of this decree is rendered with the reception of a copy by the Pastor of Saint Patrick (quasi)-Parish and by its appearance on the diocesan website.

Anything to the contrary notwithstanding.
