



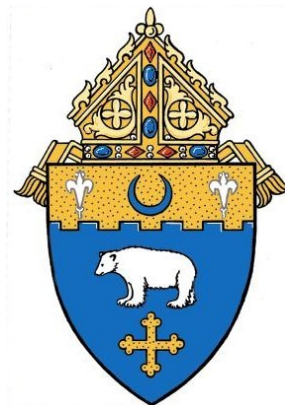
The **Chrism Mass** will be celebrated at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on Thursday, April 7, at 7 pm.

The bear is from the seal of the state of Missouri.

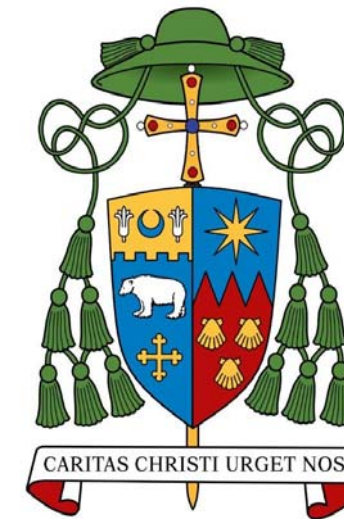
The cross is a symbol of the Catholic Faith.
